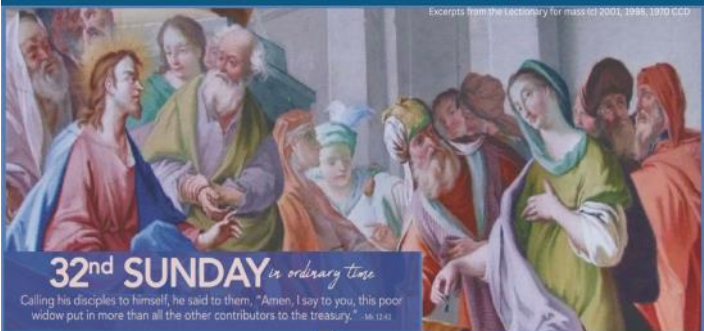

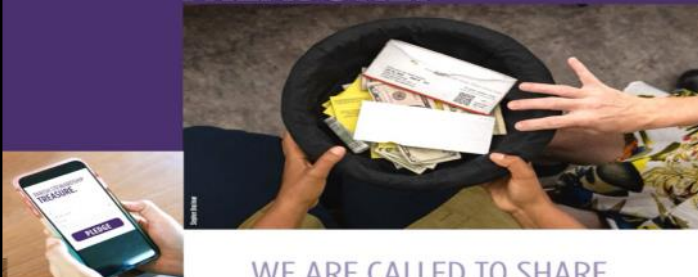

## PASTORAL NOTE

My Brothers and Sisters in Christ;

Jesus was the latest, and the last, of those whom God would send to his people. And in those days, of Jesus' time on earth, God's people were still, somewhat, that proverbial mess. The religious leaders exploited their people and lived as hypocrites under the law - saying one thing and doing another. And in the midst of this cultural sinkhole arose the sight of a firm foundation: a widow, again in our story, whose sacrifice and faithfulness drew the praise of Jesus. She paid her temple tax with money she, by all purposes, didn't have.

We don't know in the story an immediate to this widow, as transpired in the first reading. But we know Jesus sets her before his disciple-men who go forth and lead the Church after his death, resurrection and ascension-and says: "this is what discipleship looks like. Give your all, give what is worth most of you, most important to who you are, most necessary for flourishing, over to God. Sacrifice what you have out of love and devotion." Through the actions of the widow the Lord demonstrates the importance of genuine faith and the significance of sacrificial giving.

Jesus doesn't say more here, but we know the rest of the story. It is what we celebrate on this day: God's provision and faithfulness to those who trust in him.

"In those days," the high priest each year into the sanctuary with blood that was not his own. Those days are no longer. Through the actions of his Son, the Father has shown us a model of faithful obedience, who sacrifice of self, one for all ... takes away sin. On this day, we give thanks and sing praise to the Lord who will come again, and bring salvation to those who will come again, and bring salvation to those who eagerly await him.
