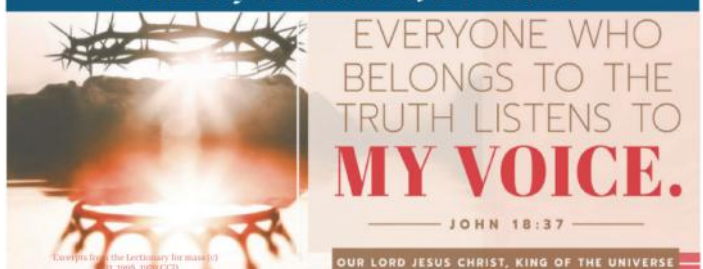

PASTORAL NOTE

My Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today is the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of Universe, and it is a feast we celebrate at the end of each liturgical year. Instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925, one of its aims is to reaffirm our belief that Christ is King and rules over all things for all time. Worldly things and worldly governments rise and fall, but Christ is now and forever.

The whole of John's Gospel is set up with a highly theological structure, filled with narratives. In it, we learn Jesus' birth was a descent from heaven. He came from God, and God is the source of his authority. God revealed himself through Jesus' earthly ministry and especially through his death and resurrection. Those who hear Jesus' voice are his disciples. To understand the truth, we must also be born from above. When we are baptized, we receive new life in Christ. We are freed from sin and reborn as members of his kingdom, priest for his God and Father.

Jesus often refers to himself as the Son of Man. He is the One in and through whom God's people are saved. We no longer hope for a future messianic kingdom, because in Jesus these hopes have been realized. If we believe in the Incarnation, the Crucifixion and the Resurrection, then eternal life is now and will continue to be available to us. This is our goal and our hope. This is the truth to which Jesus bears witness and calls us to bear witness with him.

Each of us is called to bear witness to the truth in our own sphere, whether it be in the Church or in the world. Christ the King reigns over all the earth, both now and forever. May we live out our baptismal call to make his reign known.
